#### Your Dollars At Work: A Story of Gratitude

Bess was familiar with Bridge Breast Network (BBN) and had previously donated to our program a year earlier at a community fundraiser. She never thought she could utilize our services to get her annual mammogram. You see Bess is self-employed and uninsured. It had been several years since her last mammogram and now she felt a suspicious lump that would soon be diagnosed as invasive breast cancer. The imaging center referred Bess to Parkland for care. A Parkland nurse navigator referred Bess to BBN for our survivorship services; specifically for a wig fitting because she was starting chemotherapy. Bess received more than just a wig. During our initial phone call, we learned that Bess felt lost in the Parkland system and was unsure about her diagnosis and treatment plan. Bess sign a Release of Information that allowed BBN to get copies of her mammogram and pathology reports. We then scheduled her for a wig fitting and our Breast Cancer 101. For an hour we reviewed her mammogram and pathology reports, printed and reviewed information on Triple Negative Breast Cancer, discussed nutrition and exercise options to aid in her recovery. Bess stated, "This is the most helpful information I've received regarding my cancer diagnosis and what to expect. I feel better now that I know." Bess was fitted with a wig and left with a resource binder and tools to empower her in her breast cancer journey. I'm glad we could be there for Bess. Thank you to everyone who provides donations and items for our survivorship program.

May 12, 2018 8am - 12pm

The Bridge Breast Network is partnering with Medical City Plano and Solis Mammography to provide breast cancer and skin cancer screenings on May 12 from 8 a.m to noon. One in five will be diagnosed with skin cancer. In fact, it's the most common form of cancer in the U.S. But when caught early, it can have a 98% cure rate. So spot it now. Early detection saves lives. So come out on May 12 to Medical City Plano and get screened. If you or someone you know does not have insurance and needs a mammogram, call Bridge Breast Network 214-821-3820 to be qualified and scheduled for a free mammogram on May 12.
